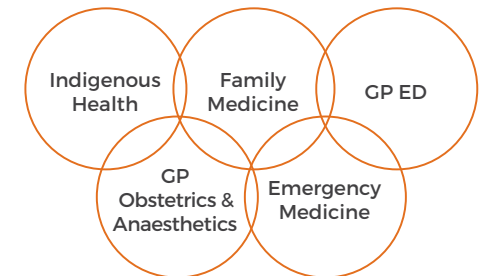

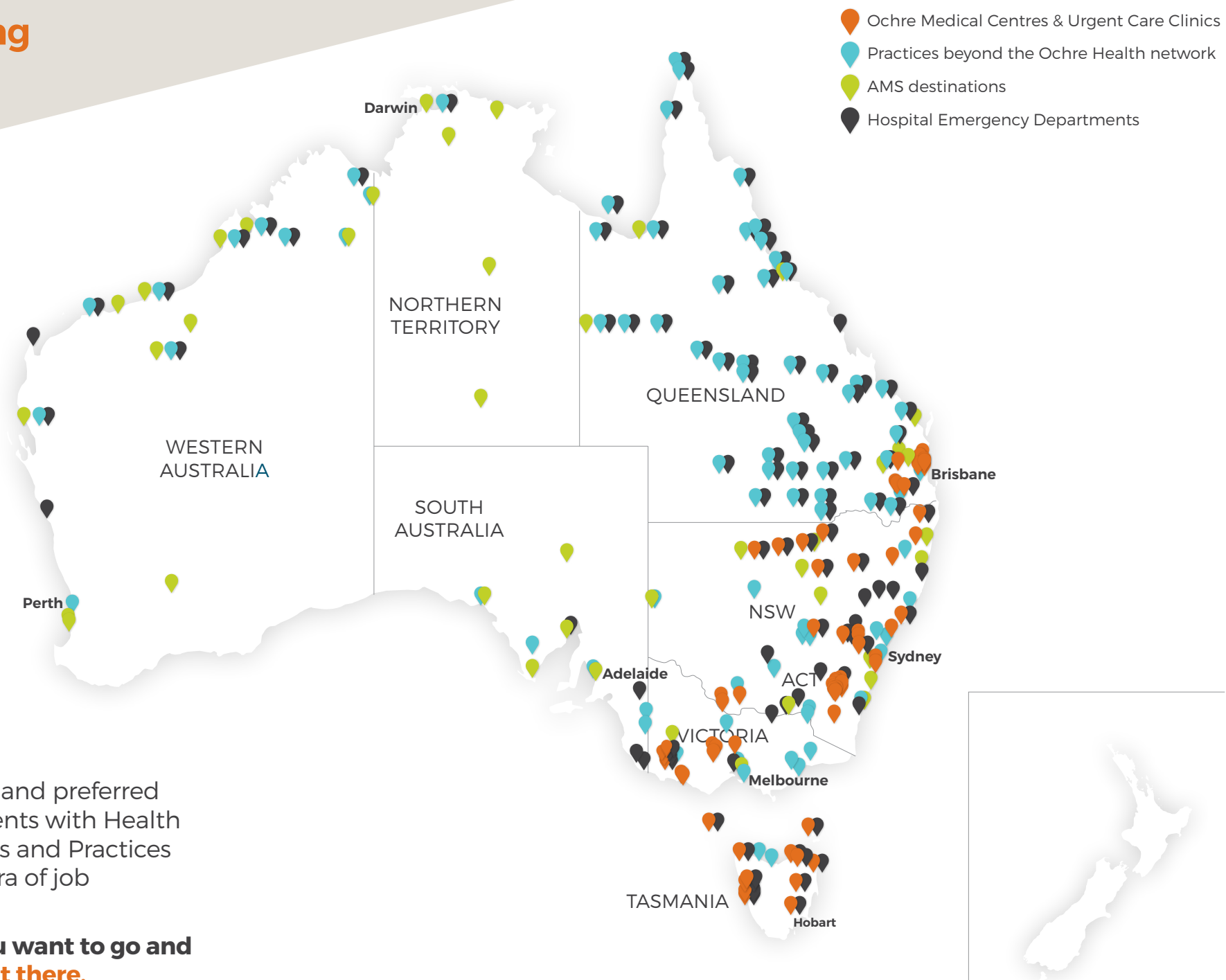

CASE STUDY

General Practitioners and Rural Generalists, Western NSW and Tasmania



Scenario

As part of the Ochre Group, we support Ochre Health contracts with medical workforce in rural, regional and urban areas of Tasmania and Western NSW. The Ochre Group partnerships with both Tassie Health and Western NSW LHD provides doctors with a diverse and interesting array of medicine you just won't find in the big smoke.

With Emergency Department and General Practice staffing resources stretched in an effort to handle the workload where patients experienced long wait periods for treatment, the Ochre group were engaged to provide a workforce solutions strategy to tackle the problem.

Our Approach

- Presentation data was analysed to determine the ratio of General Practice type vs ED presentation;
- A strategic market mapping, networking and candidate attraction campaign was developed by Ochre Recruitment to source suitable skilled doctors;

- A roster based on safety and effectiveness was implemented.

Outcome

- After identifying suitable locally based and interstate doctors, Ochre continue to recruit locum doctors who provide quality health care services in General Practice Clinics and Emergency Departments;
- Patients now receive care in a timely fashion with wait times significantly reduced;
- Patients are now treated in an appropriate setting by the highest quality clinicians;
- The community now enjoy better health outcomes;
- During 22/23 FY we provided 2,900 days of cover in Western NSW across the townships of Bourke, Brewarrina, Barham, Coonamble, Lightning Ridge, Walgett, Parkes and Dubbo;
- In Tasmania we provided 2,600 days of coverage across the length and breadth of the Apple Isle.

CASE STUDY

Indigenous Health General Practitioners, Miwatj Health Aboriginal Corporation, NT



Scenario

Miwatj Health Aboriginal Corporation is an independent Aboriginal controlled Indigenous health service in Eastern Arnhem Land near Darwin in the heart of Australia. Over half of their staff come from the Yolnu communities that they serve, however they also depend on clinicians and health professionals from elsewhere who come with an open heart.

It has been challenging for Miwatj to source doctors from outside the local communities due to the size and remote locations of many of the communities. If they don't have a GP, the clinic must rely on the nurses or the on-call services from Darwin.

Outcome

- Since June 2022, we have provided a permanent GP and six different locum doctors who secure multiple assignments during the year;
- Those locum doctors have delivered over 1504 hours of quality healthcare to the communities;
- We also provide assistance for telehealth;
- The SMO at Miwatj often refers Ochre Recruitment to other NT based clinics looking for an agency that takes the time to listen, understand and deliver.

Qualifications and experience required for the Indigenous Health specialism

Attitude and approach are central for any general practitioner looking to work with Indigenous communities. Eligible GPs need to be passionate about understanding and appreciating the uniqueness of each community they serve.

CASE STUDY

Locum GPs Tasman Medical Practice Tasmania



Scenario

Tasman Medical Practice is a general practice serving the Tasman Peninsula. They have a local permanent GP but with the demands of the surrounding population and not wanting to turn patients away or keep them, approached Ochre for additional locum support. They also required assistance with the nursing home round each week..

Outcome

- Since late 2022 Ochre have provided 34 doctors to Tasman Medical Practice;
- The locum durations range from 1 week to multiple weeks;

- 1 GP who connected with the practice and community now returns every 6-8 weeks bringing a great continuity of care;
- Many other GPs have returned on multiple occasions due to the practice values and culture and beautiful location;
- We have also identified a pool of doctors within an easy driving distance who are open to returning, including at late notice, bringing peace of mind to the clinic.

CASE STUDY

Permanent & Locum GPs, The Doctors Group & Tamaki Health Group, New Zealand



Scenario

The Doctors Group is the largest of its kind in New Zealand, with 63 practices and over 400,000 enrolled patients. Their medical teams include GPs, Nurse Practitioners and Nurses, all striving to deliver the best health care and advice. Four of their practices in Tauranga practices as well as Tamaki Health Group Christchurch approached Ochre Recruitment as they were struggling with severe staff shortages across many of their practices.

Our Approach

- In the first instance we identified our group of career locums who enjoy working their way around New Zealand in a range of practices;

- Leveraging off our extensive network of doctors who prefer more secure permanent arrangements, we initiated weekly marketing communications shining the spotlight on the different locations and practices;
- Conducted advertising campaigns on job boards and social media to attract new GPs.

Outcome

- During the past two years we have provided 10 locum doctors and a permanent GP to the Tamaki Group;
- 18 Ochre doctors have assisted practices in the Tauranga Region for the Doctors Group;
- To date, all practices are happy with the doctors put forward and continue to rely on Ochre;
